## Attend Mass

This requirement must be done first. Scouts need to attend Mass and receive the Eucharist (if made First Communion and have no moral impediment) for 12 weeks, preferably consecutively.

## Auxiliary Activity Patches

ACTIVITY	DESCRIPTION	DATE OF ACTIVITY
	<p>Scouts should either receive the Sacrament of Reconciliation or study the ten commandments if the Scout applicant has not made First Penance.</p>	
	<p>Scouts need to pray one Rosary of each of the Joyful, Luminous, Sorrowful and Glorious Mysteries.</p>	
	<p>Scouts need to participate in family prayer (at least weekly) for 12 weeks.</p>	

	<p>Scouts need to be active in ministry in your parish, such as altar server, choir member, lector, Extraordinary Minister of Holy Communion, or usher (as age appropriate).</p>	
	<p>Scouts need to attend Eucharistic Adoration (preferably with family).</p>	
	<p>Scouts need to learn about and discuss five Eucharistic Miracles.</p>	
	<p>Scouts need to be participate in a Eucharistic procession.</p>	
	<p>Younger Scouts should attend a Catholic activity, such as a diocesan Scout event, where the theme is the Eucharist. For older Scouts or and adults, attend a Catholic retreat where the theme is the Eucharist.</p>
